EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This report is a UCB's research report that comprises of scientific researches in the forms of journal articles, book chapters, and conference proceedings published by our faculty members during academic year 2020-2021. The report also includes research awards, articles published in magazines/newspapers, and keynote speeches by our faculty members. The University College of Bahrain aims to build national and international research reputation by encouraging faculty members to conduct more scientific research activities that is aligned with Bahrain's National Strategy.

The University has a total of 33 major research publications in the forms of journal articles, book chapters, and conference proceedings for AY 2020-2021. This number is significantly increased as compared to AY 2019-2020 with a total of 23 major research publications. Besides, a total of 19 other research achievements (best paper award, articles published in media, and keynote speeches) are obtained in prevailing academic year, while 11 other research achievements were obtaining in AY 2019-2020. It is worth to mention that all of those research publications by our faculty members are associated with the University College of Bahrain.

The focus areas of research at UCB are:

• Business and Management

Includes and not limited to business administration, management studies, marketing, human resource management, operations management, entrepreneurship, economics, accounting, finance, banking and financial markets, and Islamic banking and finance.

• Information Technology

Includes and not limited to management information system, software, computer network, big data, data mining, artificial intelligence, cloud computing, data analytics, and machine learning.

• Communication and Multimedia

Includes and not limited to public relations, mass communication, journalism, digital communication, corporate communication, graphic/animation, and media/multimedia.

General Studies

Includes and not limited to humanities, cultural studies, political sciences, history, sociology, business ethics, women studies, and Bahrain studies.





Figure 1.Comparison of Scientific Research Activities from AY 2019-2020 to AY 2020-2021




Figure 2. Published journal articles for AY 2020-2021

Figure 3. Published book chapters for AY 2020-2021





Figure 4. Published conference proceedings for AY 2020-2021




Figure 5. Best Paper Award for AY 2020-2021

Figure 6. Articles Published in Media for AY 2020-2021




Figure 7. Keynote Speeches for AY 2020-2021
